Chief Pryor (Police)

- Dispatch continues to have staffing struggles. Ozaukee Dispatch will begin covering third shift from 2:00AM-6:00AM starting 8/15/22 and then 12:00AM to 8:00AM on 9/1/22.
- The purchase of two squad cars was approved by Common Council at the July meeting. The squads have a longer lead time than previous orders.

Chief Bialk (Fire)

- The ambulance that was approved to be ordered will be received in summer of 2024.
- The Fire Department is continuing to work on the merger with Thiensville Fire Department. They are currently working on the budget, insurance, and dispatch.
- There is a scheduled Southern Ozaukee Fire Department Board meeting on 8/3/2022.
- The Fire Department is continuing to work on staffing issues.
