**SUBJECT: A Request from the Public Welfare Committee to Provide Input on Potential 2025 City of Mequon Community Survey Topics.**

**Background:**

The Public Welfare Committee has initiated the process for the next Community Survey, last conducted in 2019. The Committee is currently in the phase of vendor selection and question formulation, with the survey planned to be distributed in May 2025. The Committee is actively seeking suggestions from City Boards, Committees, and Commissions on potential topics to be included in the survey.

**Analysis:**

The Public Welfare Committee has asked the staff liaisons to reach out to this group to request the top three topics that your respective Board, Committee, or Commission would like to see included in the survey. Please note that a typical survey contains around 30 questions, and while all topics are important, not all can be included. The Public Welfare Committee will analyze the submitted topics to identify the most pressing themes for our community at this time.

**Recommendation:**

This committee has been requested to provide the top three topics for the upcoming survey to the Public Welfare Committee. This information is due to the Public Welfare committee by July 19, 2024.
